The information required was an estimate of the strength used by the enemy in digging a work at night on the West bank of WADI IMLEIH near HILL 410 so that a surprise attack could be made on this party.</p> <p>This officer with 4 selected men displayed great courage and dash in pushing forward, in the face of heavy fire from the enemy position on the East bank of WADI IMLEIH, actually entered the enemy works and gained the information required. A very determined attempt by two troops of enemy cavalry to cut off this party was beaten through the coolness of this officer.</p> <p>His work throughout has been consistently good.</p>	<p><i>John H.
